
### What is a Terry Towel?

Terry Towel is a fabric with loops that can absorb a substantial amount of water. The first industrial production of terry towel was initiated by the English manufacturer in 1850.



Terry Towels are woven on special looms having two beams. Longitudinal beam for passing the warp and lateral beam for weft. It can be manufactured by knitting too.

### Parts of a Terry Towel:




### Recent Trends in Towel
